The Ring of Liquid Banning is an item added by Actually Additions. When held in the hand, it will drain energy and cause all of the Water and Lava around the player in a 3 radius area to disappear. This can be disabled by holding the shift key. Each Water block removed consumes 150 Crystal Flux (CF), and each Lava block removed consumes 300 CF. The Ring of Liquid ...

The energy loss of the energy laser relays make them a really bad way of transferring power. They also look really bad. The item repairer, despite the high RF costs, is OP. The mod is barely configurable. Ellpeck does not care about fixing bugs or listening to the community. Suggestions are instantly dismissed, and the mod will never be improved.

The Firework Box is a block added by Actually Additions. It will randomly generate a Firework Rocket at the cost of 300 Crystal Flux (CF). Right-clicking the Firework Box with a Redstone Torch will change its mode. Per default, the Firework Box is deactivated by Redstone, but if configured it can be activated by Redstone pulses. The Firework Box can be right-clicked to ...

The Atomic Reconstructor is a block added by Actually Additions. It is used to create crystals and other items at the cost of 1,000 Crystal Flux per tick (CF/t). When powered, it will shoot a laser, and that laser will convert the blocks or items it hits into new blocks or items if they are convertible. Right-clicking the Atomic Reconstructor with a Redstone Torch will change its ...

The Empowerer is a block added by Actually Additions. It used to "empower" items and blocks. The Empowerer requires four Display Stands to be surrounding it, two blocks away at each side. In order to empower the center item, each Display Stand must hold a specific item and requires a minimum amount of Crystal Flux. The items (known as modifiers) and the amount of energy is ...

It will automatically plant and harvest crops in a 9x9 area in front of it at a cost of 1,500 Crystal Flux (CF) per operation. The left side of its GUI contains Seeds (what it will plant) and the right side contains harvested goods. The Farmer on ...

The Vertical Digger is a block added by Actually Additions. It will mine blocks, at the cost of 650 Crystal Flux (CF) per block mined. The Vertical Digger has two modes- "Mining Everything" and "Only Mining Ores". Each do as they describe. Per default, the Vertical Digger has a radius of 2 blocks, meaning it mines in a 5x5 area. Placing a Phantom Booster on top of it will double the ...

The Double Battery is an item added by Actually Additions. It is used store Crystal Flux (CF) in item form. The Double Battery can be charged in an Energizer and discharged in an Enervator. Shift right-clicking it will

turn on "discharge mode", where it will charge any CF items in the users' inventory. Shift right-clicking again will turn it off. The Double Battery on the online Actually ...

When placed, the Player Interface will automatically be connected to the player's inventory. Items can be pumped in or out of the Player Interface, and those items will be pumped in or out from the player's inventory accordingly; the Player Interface acts as a way to ...

The base Coffee will require an Empty Cup, 15 Coffee Beans, 500 mb of Water and Crystal Flux. Coffee can be amplified with special effects by adding items in the top right corner of the machine; more information can be found on the Cup with Coffee page. ...

The Item Laser Relay is a block added by Actually Additions. It will wirelessly transmit items to another Item Laser Relay when connected. The Item Laser Relay can be connected by right-clicking two pairs with a Laser Wrench. Items will only flow through the Item Relay if one is connected to an Item Interface and another is connected to another inventory. Items put into ...

Phantom Energyface is a block added by the Actually Additions mod. It allows to use the energy of linked blocks. A Phantom Connector must be used to provide info about selected position to the Phantom Energyface.. Phantom Energyface has a default range of 16 blocks, but it can be upgraded with 1-3 Phantom Boosters placed at the top of it. Any booster doubles the previous ...

The ESD is a block added by Actually Additions. It is an advanced version of the Hopper. Within the GUI, the side used for its input and output can be configured. Additionally, the slot ranges in the inventory that are pulled from/pushed to by the ESD can be configured. One slot is added for an Item Filter. When added, the items in the Item Filter will be whitelisted in the ESD. The ...

The Double Crusher is a block added by Actually Additions. It does the same operations as the Crusher, but it has two slots for input. It is as fast as the Crusher, but it will consume twice as much energy while crushing two Ores at once. The Double Crusher on the online Actually Additions Manual

The Storage Crate Keeper is an item added by Actually Additions. When placed in a Storage Crate of any variety (Small, Medium, or Large), the Storage Crate will keep its items when broken. The Heat Collector is a block added by Actually Additions. It will generate 40 Crystal Flux per tick (CF/t) when surrounded by four Lava blocks. Each 1,000 ticks, there is a 0.5% chance of one of the Lava blocks being consumed, or a 0.5% chance per 50 seconds, or a 36% chance per hour. Before version 1.11-r86, each tick, there is a 0.01% chance of one of the Lava blocks being ...
