How to fix system UI is not responding error on Android?

Resetting app preferences can sometimes help fix the "System UI is Not Responding" error on your Android smartphone. App settings refer to the default settings and permissions that apps need to work and interact with your device. When you reset the app permissions, all the default apps will be deleted.

How to fix 'system UI has stopped' error on Android?

Corrupt system UI cache files are a common reason behind the dreaded 'System UI has stopped' error on Android. Clearing them manually from the Android settings app should fix it. Step 1: Open the Settings app &gt; select Apps &gt; tap the three-dot menu at the top right &gt; select Show system apps.

What happens if system UI stops working on Android?

When the System UI stops working on your Android device, you may experience problems such as the screen freezing, apps closing, buttons not responding, problems with notifications, or even the device rebooting. But do not worry. There are several methods you can use to fix this problem.

How do I fix Android system UI problems?

Open "System UI" and select the "Storage and Cache" option. If the problem persists, you can also try clearing the cache for Google Play Services and the Google app using the same process. These apps can also contribute to system UI issues on Android. 2. Update Apps Using outdated apps can often cause problems.

What causes Android system UI to stop abruptly?

A buggy Google Update is another common culprit for Android System UI stopping abruptly. Access your device settings to uninstall it manually. Step 1: Long-tap the Google icon in the app drawer and tap App info. Step 2: Select the vertical three-dot menu at the top right and tap Uninstall updates.

Tap on the three-dot menu at the top right and select "Show system" or "Show system apps." Use the search option to find the "System UI" app. Open "System UI" and select the "Storage and Cache" option. Tap on "Clear cache" to clean the cache of the System UI app.

If Android system UI has stopped and you cannot enter your home screen, press the Power button, and select Power off to shut down your phone. Step 2. Next, hold down Volume Up/Down and Power buttons at the same time until the boot screen appears.

These fixes will get your Android device working like clockwork in no time at all. ... Press and hold the power button until the Power menu appears. ... Now, go back to the apps page and tap on "System UI". Again, tap on "Storage and Cache" for the app.
