

Android system recovery without power button

How to use Android recovery mode without a power button?

To use Android recovery mode without a power button to reboot your phone, you have to first get it into the mode. There are specific key combinations available for different devices to trigger the "recovery" menu. Check the one for your phone in the user manual or from its official website.

How to restart an Android phone without a power button?

The Shutdown is among the most reliable third-party apps to restart an Android phone with no power button after giving permission to it. Fix how to restart an Android phone without a power button via a three-party app like Shutdown: Get the Shutdown from Google Play Store. Give the permission on startup. Tap on "Open Power Menu".

How do I fix Android stuck in recovery mode?

Press and hold down the "Power" button for around 15 seconds. When you see the manufacturer logo on its screen, let go of the button to troubleshoot Android stuck in recovery mode. If it doesn't work, hold down the "Power" and "Volume Up" buttons for about 15 seconds until your phone restart. 2. Perform a factory data reset

How to exit Android recovery mode by factory reset?

Next, let's figure out how to exit Android recovery mode by factory reset: Use the "Volume Up"/"Volume Down" button to highlight "wipe data"/"factory reset". Confirm the option with the "Power" button. Choose "Yes" using both the "Volume" and "Power" keys. This phone will do a factory data reset at once.

How do I Reboot my Android phone?

Press and hold the "Volume" and "Power"/"Home" buttons simultaneously. When you get into the boot menu, go to "reboot system now" using the "Volume Up"/"Volume Down" buttons. In most Recoveries (stock and custom), the Power button might be needed to boot into Recovery, with the navigation buttons for the various options typically being Home (or Bixby), Volume Up, and Volume Down.

Many devices reboot when you hold down the power button. However, it may take 10 to 20 seconds before it's triggered. If that doesn't work, try holding down both the Power and Volume Up buttons for up to 20 seconds. After that, the screen will go black, signaling that the device has powered down.
