What is Austin energy value of solar program?

Austin Energy Value of Solar Program: This incentive from Austin Energy is similar to Solar Renewable Energy Certificates (SRECs). You get paid for every kWh your system generates at a rate determined by your system size and eligibility.

Who is eligible for Austin Energy's solar rebate & incentives?

Only the participating solar contractors listed here are eligible to offer Austin Energy's rebate and incentives to customers who install solar power at their home or business.

Does Austin Energy sell solar installations?

According to Carlos Cordova, Austin Energy's corporate communications manager, "Austin Energy does not sell solar installations". Utility employees do not make solar solicitations to customers. Only registered installers that have met the program requirements are authorized to promote the solar rebates.
