What happened to Dodger Stadium?

Ground was broken for Dodger Stadium on September 17, 1959. The tops of local ridges were removed, and the soil was used to fill in Sulfur and Cemetery Ravines to provide a level surface for a parking lot and the stadium.

Being on the East side of the stadium, these seats see the most sun in the stadium. Rows are lettered A-V. In previous seasons these seats were a part of the All-You-Can-Eat Pavilion, but that changed with the renovations for the 2020 season.
