How long do business energy contracts last?

Business energy contracts can last for up to five years and you will usually have a contract for each type of energy you use. Most energy suppliers will not let you switch suppliers before the end of the contract. The amount of energy your business uses is recorded by suppliers every half an hour. This is part of a process called 'settlement'.

Rollover contracts are similar to deemed rate contracts in that a supplier will switch your business to this type of contract if you don't negotiate a new deal at the end of your current one ...
