Can I install solar panels if I don't meet building regulations?

Your local authority can also apply for a Confiscation Order to take away any money you've earned with your system - so there's absolutely no benefit to installing solar panels that don't meet building regulations. It's crucial that your solar installation follows all building regulations.

Are solar panels legal?

However, it's crucial to understand that while installing solar panels is legal, certain conditions must be met. For most domestic properties, solar panel installations are considered a "permitted development" and do not require planning permission, provided they respect certain size criteria.

While it is possible to install solar panels yourself in the UK, it is generally recommended to hire a professional installer. This is because solar panel installation can be complex and requires specialised knowledge and equipment. Do I need permission to install solar panels?

Nevertheless, if your building is listed or located in a conservation area, you will need to seek specific permissions. It's paramount that any solar panel installation is carried out by the Microgeneration Certification Scheme (MCS).
