How much does a solar panel cost?

Less efficient polycrystalline panels are typically cheaper at \$0.75 per watt, putting the price of a 400-watt panel at \$300. The cost of a solar panel also depends on how you buy it. How much does a solar system cost for a 3,000 square foot home?

Solar panel systems on homes are typically up to 4kWp. A system of this size can generate more than 3,000kWh per year. For comparison, a home using a "medium" amount of electricity gets through 2,700kWh a year on average, according to energy regulator Ofgem.

The average cost of solar panels for a three bedroom house is just over \$20,000 after claiming the 30% solar tax credit. However, the size and cost of a solar system depends more on your electricity consumption than the number of bedrooms in your house, and can be substantially impacted by large electrical loads like air conditioning and EV ...
