Gas vs. Propane for your Generac Generator Generac home backup generators are designed to run on one of two fuel sources: natural gas or propane. They are factory-set to run on natural gas, but at the time of installation, your generator can be reconfigured to run on liquid propane.

How much propane does a Generac home standby generator need?

Propane tanks that supply fuel to a Generac home standby generator must be at least 250 gallons. However, every home is different, and so is every installation and set-up. A free in-home assessment will help determine the best setup tailored to a specific home or site.

Can a generator be converted to propane?

Some generator models can also be converted between fuel types. For example, Generac home standby generators 7 kW-48 kW are shipped as natural gas from the factory and can be converted in the field for liquid propane.

Generac generators are about the same loudness as the average air conditioner. By law, permanent generators must be below certain decibel thresholds, so they should all be pretty tolerable. At least, the sound will be more tolerable than the aggravation of another power outage!

Using the chart below, Taylor finds that his 10kW Guardian Series Generator consumes .97 gallons of LPG (liquid propane) per hour when running at half load. To simplify, he rounds up to 1 gallon. This means that Taylor's generator will consume about 1 gallon of LPG every hour it's running at half load.

How Long Will a 1000-gallon Propane Tank Run a Generator? Most propane-powered generators have a maximum capacity of 1,000 gallons. At a typical rate of burning 2 to 3 gallons per hour, a 1,000-gallon propane tank can run a generator for about 200 (8.3 days) to 400 hours (16.7 days).

For example, a 16-kilowatt Generac generator running at 50% load consumes 2.76 gallons of propane per hour, meaning that it can run for approximately 180 hours (7.5 days) continuously on 250 gallons of propane.

Generac also has an "exercise" feature where, at a predetermined day of the week and time, your generator will kick on and do an "exercise". Every week or every other week at the set time, the generator will run for a few minutes to warm up the engine and make sure everything is working as it should., then shut itself down.

Here are more exact estimates based on the size of your generator and assuming an average 50% load on the generator during the outage. 22kw Generac: 48 hours on 120 gallon tank / 197 hours on a 500 gallon tank. 20kw Generac: 50 hours on 120 gallon tank / 210 hours on a 500 gallon tank
