



Grants for renewable energy scotland

A fund to help community groups across Scotland set up renewable energy generation projects has opened for applications. The £1.5 million Community Energy Generation Growth Fund will support local communities installing wind turbines and solar panels or developing other types of renewable energy generation, such as hydro, to meet local needs.

This offers grants of £7,500, which increases to £9,000 for people in remote areas who qualify for the rural uplift. In Scotland, you can also apply for an interest-free loan of up to £7,500 to cover the remaining costs.

Quarterly figures show Scotland generated the most renewable electricity in the first half of any year, generating 7312 Gigawatt hours (GWh) in the second quarter of 2024 - a 27.9% increase from the same period in 2023..
