How much does a solar system cost?

Solar panel costs are calculated by the price per watt. The average price per watt in the U.S. is \$3.67 for an 8.6 kW system (rounded up). Compare the average cost of solar in the U.S. based on system size before applying incentives. To estimate how much a system will cost, multiply the price per watt by the system size.

How much does it cost to install a solar panel?

Solar panels generate "free" electricity, but installing a system still costs money. A typical 8-kilowatt (kW) solar panel system costs \$22,712 before considering any financial incentives. Your energy needs determine the system size you need, which affects the overall price of your solar panel installation.

How much do solar panels cost per watt?

The average cost per watt for solar panels in the U.S. is \$2.84 for residential systems. High-efficiency monocrystalline panels tend to be at the higher end of the price range, but they generate more power with fewer panels--ideal if you have limited roof space.

How much does a 5 kilowatt solar system cost?

That price effectively drops to \$19,873 after considering the full federal solar tax credit.
