



How to dispose of cell phone battery

Recycle your batteries in a local battery drop-off bin or at a recycling centre. What to avoid when recycling lithium-ion batteries: Do not throw out batteries in your regular household garbage or recycling bin. Do not burn batteries in a fire, they may explode. Don't mix damaged, and non-damaged batteries.

Where can I safely dispose of a swollen battery? If the battery is not smoking and appears safe to move, you can take it to an authorized battery collection site or recycling center, which will safely dispose of it. To find your closest facility, visit Call2Recycle . You should never put a swollen battery in your trash can or recycling bin.

Handle any damaged battery with care and appropriate personal protective equipment. If a lithium-ion battery becomes damaged, contact the battery or device manufacturer for specific handling information. EPA recommendation: Look for labels identifying battery chemistry. Do not put rechargeable batteries in the trash or municipal recycling bins.

Once you have information on your local laws regarding battery disposal, you will need to find appropriate hazardous waste disposal or recycling facilities in your area. Some areas also offer home hazardous waste collection programs or regularly scheduled events in which you take your batteries to a designated collection site. [6]

Keep batteries out of your regular recycling bin. Household batteries are recycled separately from other items. Mixing batteries in with other recyclables can result in a fire, as the battery can spark. You'll need to take your batteries to a facility that collects batteries. Even a battery that has lost its charge can spark.
