

# How to fix power button on beats solo 3

How to reset a Beats Solo 3?

To reset your Beats Solo 3, press the volume down button and power button for 10 seconds. After a few seconds, the LED light will flash, then you have to release the buttons. Your headphones have now been reset. This is the solution for most issues and the headphones will turn off after completing this step.

You won't see your Beats in your list of available Bluetooth devices unless they are in Pairing Mode. Press and hold the Power button on your Beats headphones or earbuds for about five seconds, or until you see the lights fade in and out. After they are in Pairing Mode, they should show up in your list of available devices.
