

# How to install the generator fan cover

Can a tent cover a generator if it rains?

Also known as generator tents, there are various styles of pop-up canopy or tent covers that can be purchased to cover a generator to enable it to be run whilst it is raining. These are normally waterproof tarp that have a panel covering the sensitive electrical components of the equipment.

How do you install a generator enclosure?

Attach the front "door" of the generator enclosure to the sides using hinges. Attach one latch to the top of the door and fasten the second latch to the bottom. Close the latches. 8. Attach the top of the generator box to the sides, driving deck screws into the 2x2 sections. 9. If you use roofing material, add it to the enclosure's top. 10.
