Are solar panels legal?

However, it's crucial to understand that while installing solar panels is legal, certain conditions must be met. For most domestic properties, solar panel installations are considered a "permitted development" and do not require planning permission, provided they respect certain size criteria.

Are solar panels legal in the UK?

All electrical work in the UK must comply with the national standard, BS 7671. Therefore, it's not just about the legality but also the safety and reliability of your solar panel system. While the Feed-in Tariff (FIT) scheme has concluded for new applicants, those already part of it continue to benefit from the incentive.

Can I install solar panels if I don't meet building regulations?

Your local authority can also apply for a Confiscation Order to take away any money you've earned with your system - so there's absolutely no benefit to installing solar panels that don't meet building regulations. It's crucial that your solar installation follows all building regulations.
