How many solar companies are MNRE approved?

In the first list of ALMM, there were only 23 solar companies that got approval. From an initial 23 manufacturers adding up to 8200 MW of total capacity, the list today has expanded to 78 manufacturers with a capacity of over 22,000 MW. With this latest revision, the number of MNRE-approved solar companies has been reduced from 82 to 78.

What is MNRE approved solar panel manufacturers in India?

The MNRE Approved Solar Panel Manufacturers in India list is a crucial guideline set by the government to ensure that solar panels used in the country meet high standards of quality and reliability. Being on this list means that companies have passed rigorous tests and certifications set by the Ministry of New and Renewable Energy (MNRE).

How many domestic module manufacturers are included in MNRE list?

The latest list of ALMM was updated on the 24th of Jan 2024. This is the 14th revision since it was first introduced. In the first list of ALMM, there were only 23 solar companies that got approval.

Who are the new solar companies in India?

Central Electronics Ltd., Patanjali, and Jakson were later added to the list. Later in October the new additions were made - Himalayan Solar, Sun N Sand Exim, Insolation Energy, Pennar Industries, Green Brilliance Renewable Energy, Sanelite Solar, Gautam Solar, and Solarium Green Energy.
