

# New Energy Wind and Solar Power Generation

Will wind & solar power grow in 2023?

Wind and solar power generation is growing by around 15-20% per year - based on a 10-year average - and looks set to outstrip any increases in annual electricity demand by the end of 2023 as they are, in many countries, already cheaper and strategically more secure than fossil fuels.

How will solar PV & wind impact global electricity generation?

The share of solar PV and wind in global electricity generation is forecast to double to 25% in 2028 in our main case. This rapid expansion in the next five years will have implications for power systems worldwide.

What percentage of EU electricity is generated by wind & solar?

For the first time, more than a quarter of EU electricity (27%) was provided by wind and solar in 2023, up from 23% in 2022. This drove renewable electricity to a record high of 44%, passing the 40% mark for the first year in the EU's history. Combined wind and solar generation increased by a record 90 TWh and installed capacity by 73 GW.

What can be done to improve the future of wind and solar power?

These possible solutions include long-term strategic planning, upgrades to power systems, more advanced variable renewable technology, additional distributed resources and policies that encourage projects with greater system value.
