How much does New Hampshire get from solar for all?

New Hampshire will receive more than \$43 million through the EPA's Solar for All program to bring the benefits of solar to low income households across the state. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) announced that the State of New Hampshire has been selected to receive \$43,510,000 from the Solar for All competitive grant program.

Does New Hampshire have solar metering?

New Hampshire's net metering program is pretty good, but installing a battery helps you keep more of your own (free) solar power rather than letting the utility company take it at a discount. What are the best solar companies in New Hampshire?

The New Hampshire solar property tax exemption excludes the added value of a solar installation in New Hampshire from your home's value for tax purposes. Net metering is a policy that enables your solar panels to be connected to the public-utility power grid.

Sep. 20--At first glance, it looks like a scam -- and not a very sophisticated one at that. Mailings promoting "free" conversions to solar power have been arriving in New Hampshire mailboxes.

The average New Hampshire homeowner needs a 9.98 kW solar panel system to cover their electricity needs, which comes out to \$32,341 before incentives. Prices range from \$27,490 to \$37,192, but after the federal tax credit, that drops by 30%. While this may sound high, it will pay off in New Hampshire.

Despite having one of the nation's smaller solar markets, New Hampshire is dedicated to expanding its renewable energy potential. The state aims to generate at least 25.5% of its electricity from clean energy by 2025. Using more solar energy will also help its residents save on higher-than-average electricity rates.

The New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission ("PUC") offers a rebate of \$200 per kilowatt (kW), up to \$1,000 or 30% of project costs, whichever is less, for residential solar power systems. However, due to the maximum incentive of \$1,000, this effectively sets a cap of approximately 5-kW for the rebate.
