Can a solar PV system be installed on a factory roof?

As factories are energy-intensive buildings, installing a solar PV system on the roof of a factory ensures free power can be generated to run everything underneath it. What is a roof-mounted Photovoltaic (PV) system?

Roof-mounted Photovoltaic (PV) systems are commonly used in commercial buildings, reaching up to 100kW, and a maximum of 1MW. Industrial PV systems, in the range of (0.5-10) MW, can be installed on very large roofs. A roof-mounted PV system is an example, as shown in the power plant installed on the roof of the factory GRUNER Serbian Ltd. The main purpose of the solar power plant is to generate electricity.

How do roof mounted PV solar panels work?

Roof mounted PV Solar Panels are typically supported by racking systems which come in two basic forms. The first is a mechanically fastened system and the second, the more common of the two, is a ballast restrained system. The mechanically fastened system penetrates through the roofing membrane and can be used in pitched roofs and flat roofs.

Why do solar panels need a roof?

The roof plays a vital role in the solar panel installation process, as it provides the necessary support for the panels. To prevent potential damage to the roof and ensure the safe operation of the solar energy system, there are several factors to consider:

Can a solar power plant be installed on a large roof?
