An "acrostic poem" is a poem in which the first letter of each line -- read vertically -- spells out a word or a message. The word "acrostic" comes from the Greek words "akros" (outermost) and "stichos" (line of verse) usually, the word or message spelled out by the first letters of each line is the overall subject of the acrostic poem.. Here is an example of a simple acrostic poem:
