



Solar light bracket disassembly diagram

How to install a solar panel bracket?

First, lie down the pole on the ground, use M10*30 and M10*25 bolts and nuts fix well part code#1/2/3/4(match the part code in the drawing) on the top of the pole. Let the cable of solar panel go through the flange of bracket. Adjust the incline direction of bracket, face to the right south, use M12*25 bolt fix well the flange of bracket.

How do I connect a floodlight bracket to a solar panel?

Connect the floodlight and solar panel cables (see below). Check the waterproof cable connector(s) are secure. Follow steps 4 and 5 above. Attach the relevant 76mm or 60mm brackets to both the floodlight bracket and solar panel bracket as per the instructions. Mount the bracket securely onto the column with the solar panel as high as possible.

How do you mount a solar engine?

Connect the mounting adapter to the solar engine. Mount the solar engine on the post, feeding the cables down the post. Mount the LED light bar universal bracket(s) to the post. Mount the LED light bar(s) to the universal bracket(s), pulling the cables through the light bar and connect the wires to the LED's.

How do you strip a solar light wire?

1. Look for the wire gauge specification of the solar light wire you have. This is usually printed at the cable sheath. 2. Secure the wire at the right gauge slot of the wire stripper at about 1/8 inch from the end. 3. Gently clamp the stripper on the wire and twist back and forth a few times until you feel the insulation cut off.

How to install solar string lights?

Note: To disconnect the solar panel (4) Structural installation: To create a draping effect for the solar string lights attach the first bulb to a structure, then only mount every 3-4th bulb to create the desired effect. Complete the effect by from the mounting bracket, press mounting the last bulb to a structure.

How to connect a solar panel to a lamp pole?

Do not mess the junction wires of solar panel in the gap of bracket and lamp pole. First, lie down the pole on the ground, use M10*30 and M10*25 bolts and nuts fix well part code#1/2/3/4(match the part code in the drawing) on the top of the pole.
