Which UK city has the most solar panels?

When it comes down to parliamentary constituencies, Peterborough has the most solar panel installations in the UK, with 6,921, as of September 2023. This puts the city just ahead of its regional counterpart South Cambridgeshire, which has 6,727 installations.

Are solar panels a good investment in the UK?

Wales is second with 6.01%, just ahead of the East Midlands on 5.63%. There are savings to be gained beyond the south and central regions of the UK, as shown by the fact that 4.83% of homes in North East England have solar panels - which is above the national average.
