What is an APC in the military?

An Armored Personnel Carrier (APC) is a type of military vehicle designed to transport troops and equipment safely across hostile environments. It is heavily armored to protect its occupants and is equipped with weapons for self-defense.

What is an APC & how does it work?

According to the definition in the Treaty on Conventional Armed Forces in Europe, an APC is "an armoured combat vehicle which is designed and equipped to transport a combat infantry squad and which, as a rule, is armed with an integral or organic weapon of less than 20 millimetres calibre." [1]

What does a professional APC do?

APCs can also present foreign and self lipids to T cells and natural killer cells by using the CD1 family of proteins, which are structurally similar to the MHC class I family. [4] Professional APCs specialize in presenting antigens to T cells. [5]

What are Ambulatory Payment Classifications (APCs)?

All items and services paid under the OPSS are assigned to payment groups called Ambulatory Payment Classifications (APCs), which group together items and services that are similar clinically and in terms of resource use. Under the OPSS, APC payments are made for items and services furnished by hospital outpatient departments.

When are APC payments made to hospitals?

APC payments are made to hospitals when the Medicare outpatient is discharged from the Emergency Department or clinic or is transferred to another hospital (or other facility) which is not affiliated with the initial hospital where the patient received outpatient services.

Each APC contains services similar in resource utilization, clinical intensity, and cost. All services grouped under the same APC then result in an annually updated Medicare "prospective payment" for the APC. The APC is a prospective and fixed payment, ...
