Where to dispose of batteries?

Where can I recycle a car battery?

For small primary batteries, simply locate a local battery recycling center near you. For rechargeable batteries, like the ones used in cell phones, remote controls, and cameras, most retailers that sell them are required to accept and recycle them. As for batteries that are used for cars or golf carts, they are simply banned from landfills.

How do you dispose of a lithium battery?

Contact the manufacturer or local solid waste authority for additional management options. Handling precautions: Place each battery in separate plastic bags or place non-conductive tape (e.g., electrical tape) over the battery's terminals or around the entire button. A lithium battery may spark and cause fires if damaged or the terminal ends touch.

Where can I drop off a used battery?

Just Collect, Protect and Drop Off your used batteries at one of our participating drop-off locations across the U.S. You can find our drop boxes at general retailers, home improvement stores, grocery stores, municipal recycling centers, and other facilities near you. Don't throw out that one used battery you just replaced.

Where can I recycle Li-ion batteries?

Li-ion batteries in electronics: Send electronic devices containing Li-ion batteries to certified electronics recyclers, participating retailers and recyclers in electronics takeback services or contact your local solid waste or household hazardous waste collection program for more options.

Can I recycle a damaged lithium ion battery?

It may require special handling. Damaged lithium metal or lithium-ion batteries are considered especially hazardous and should not be placed in a regular Call2Recycle box for recycling. Follow instructions here for handling these unusual circumstances. More frequently asked questions

Yes, lithium batteries can be recycled under the definition of solid waste recycling exclusion at 40 CFR 261.4(a)(24) and/or 40 CFR 261.4(a)(25) (for recycling occurring domestically and after export, respectively) as long as (1) both the state that the batteries are generated in and the state in which the recycling takes place have adopted ...

The state recycling law requires battery retailers to post a sign stating &quot;Recycle Automotive Batteries Here.&quot; The sign must be 8.5 x 11 inches and be visible to customers. If a lithium-ion battery becomes damaged, contact the battery or device manufacturer for specific handling information. EPA recommendation: Look for labels identifying battery chemistry. Do not put rechargeable batteries in the trash or municipal recycling bins. Find a recycling location near you: Ni-Cd; Li-ion; Ni-MH; Ni-Zn; Pb; Lithium-Ion ...

Non-rechargeable and alkaline household batteries may be discarded with regular trash. However, it is illegal to put rechargeable batteries in your trash or recycling. This includes batteries from laptops, cell phones, and digital cameras. If you need to get rid of rechargeable batteries, you can: Drop them off at a Special Waste Disposal site

How to Recycle Right. The first rule in managing batteries safely is to always follow the manufacturer's instructions. Here are additional tips on preparing batteries for recycling. Collect and sort your batteries by type (e.g., lithium-ion, alkaline). Put on latex gloves to avoid any possible contact with powder or acid that can burn your skin.

These batteries need to be shipped separately from other types. It is especially dangerous to ship them with Lithium batteries of any kind. During the recycling process for lead-acid batteries, they are crushed. When lithium batteries are crushed in the same container, they explode. Lithium batteries need to be recycled and cannot go into the ...
